

Craighead Forest Park Campground Rules

1. Pets must be on a leash at all times.
 - a. Owner(s) must continually clean up after pets.
 - b. Pets disturbing other campers must be brought under control by the owner(s) immediately or removed from the park.
2. Alcoholic beverages or drugs are prohibited.
3. Personal items should be kept in proper vehicles, tents, or RV.
4. Campsites must be kept clean at all times and not littered. No clothing lines allowed.
5. Riotous, boisterous, threatening, or indecent conduct and/or language are prohibited.
6. Campers are responsible for their guest(s). Guests must leave during quiet time hours of 10:00PM to 7:00AM.
7. Gray water may run on the ground. Sewage line dumping must be done at the dump station. (Eviction, notification of the Health Department, and/or clean-up costs will apply for violators)
8. Use of ATV's is not permitted. All motorized vehicles used outside of the campground must be "street legal".
Golf carts are permitted within the campground only.
9. No water hydrant connections are allowed when the temperature is at or below freezing. (35°F)
10. No outside appliances or wood bricks. (Refrigerator, freezer, washers, air conditioners etc.)
11. No soliciting is allowed.
12. Quiet time is 10:00PM to 7:00AM
13. Checkout time is 1:00PM. Must make payment by 1:00PM to secure spot at a discounted rate. Rate will increase to \$25 per night if payment is made after 1:00PM.
14. Maximum stay for prime campsites (closest to the lake) is 14 days within a 30-day period. Extended stay campers may relocate to a less desirable site for an additional 14 days when the campground is not at capacity.
15. Maximum stay is 28 days within a 30-day period. Extensions must be approved by the Parks Director. Camping extensions will not qualify for any discounts beyond the initial 14 days.
16. After two warnings, parks personnel may revoke camping privileges based upon the severity of the offense.
